Venue Description

Sadly due to building regulations Belgrave Music Hall does not have step free access in all areas of the venue. The main bar space has step free access via a side door – please contact a member of the team to arrange access through this entrance. To access the performance space at Belgrave Music Hall there are 22 steps up. There are 2 accessible toilets within the building, one outside the performance space and one in the main bar.

Travel Guide

The venue is located at **1-1a Cross Belgrave Street, Leeds, LS28JP**.

Unfortunately, Belgrave Music Hall does not have its own parking facilities. The nearest car park to the venue is Citi Park Merrion Centre. This is 0.2 miles or 322 metres away and has accessible parking spaces.

Blue badge parking spaces can be found on Belgrave Street, 427 ft (130 metres) from the venue. A link to blue badge parking spaces in Leeds can be found [here](#).

For taxis and drop offs, there is space outside the front of the venue.

Leeds station is 0.6 miles (966 metres) away (New Station St, Leeds, LS14DY).

Leeds bus station is 0.4 miles or 644 metres away (Dyer St, Leeds, LS2 7LA).

The closest bus stop is 289ft (89 metres) away (New Briggate Stop N4, New Briggate, Leeds, LS28JD).
